



Rulla Rondelles



Material (for one bead)

Matubo Rulla (8 pcs)

Matubo 11/0 R or 11/0 Japanese seed beads
(8 pcs)

15/0 Japanese seed beads (preferably Miyuki)
(40 pcs, approx. 0.25 gram)

Beading needle and thread (Nymo, Fireline...)

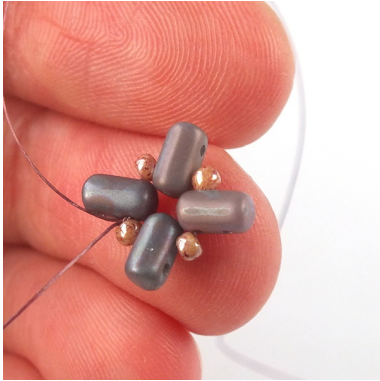
Optional: 4mm bicones or 3mm rounds (two for each beaded bead bead), accent beads (6-10mm rounds, firepolished beads, gemstone chips), 11/0 seed beads, beading wire, bead tips, crimp beads, jump rings, a clasp

Difficulty: For beginners

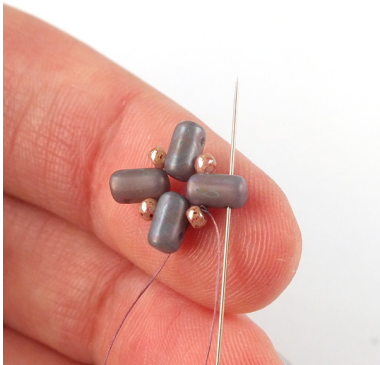
1) String one Rulla, one 11/0, one Rulla, one 11/0 ... total four of each.



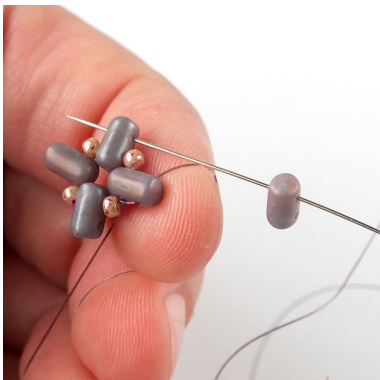
2) Slide all the beads to the end of the thread and tie a square knot to form a circle. This is what you should get.



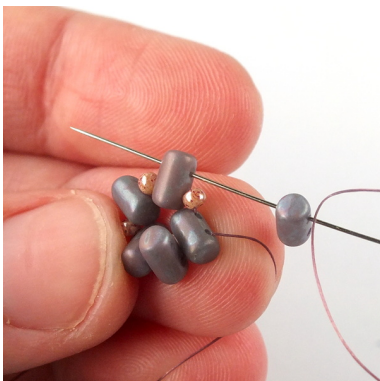
3) Pass through the upper hole of the nearest Rulla.



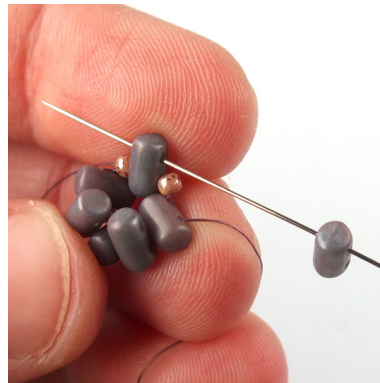
4) Add one new Rulla and pass through the upper hole of the next Rulla in the first row.



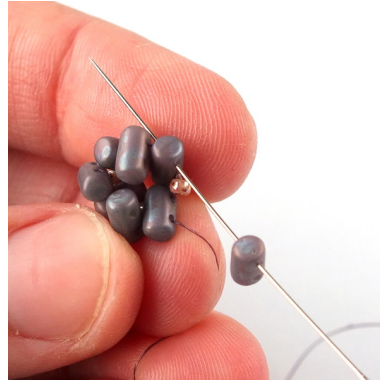
5) Repeat step 4 ...



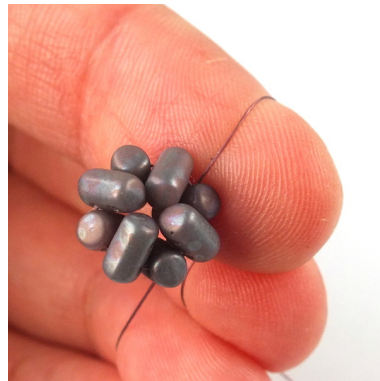
6) ... until you reach ...



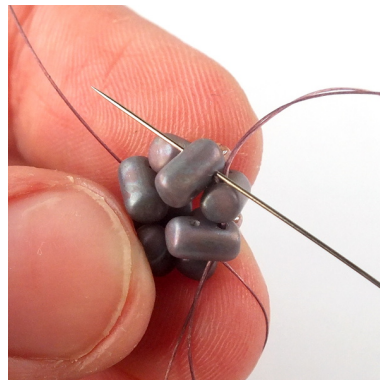
7) ... the end of the row.



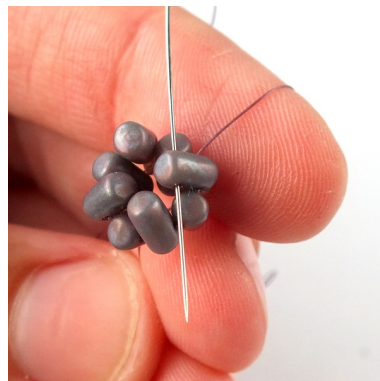
8) All the new Rullas should be folded inside, as shown in the photo. For better tension you can weave through the entire row one or two more times.

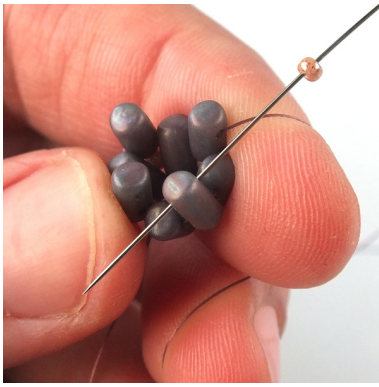


9) Weave through beads to get to the lower hole of the nearest new Rulla.

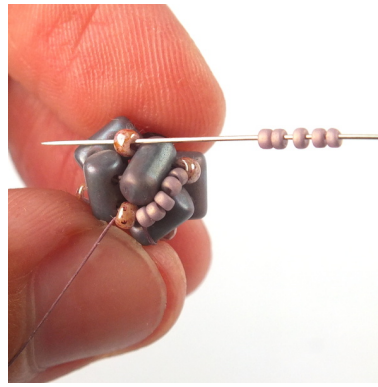


10) Then pass back through the upper hole of the same Rulla.





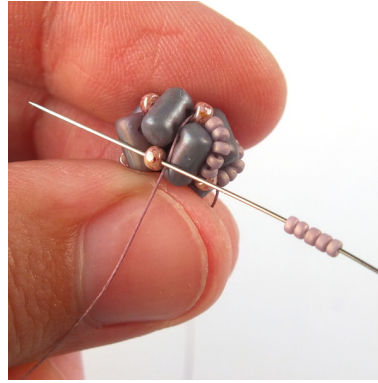
11) Add one 11/0 and pass through the upper hole of the next new Rulla in the row.



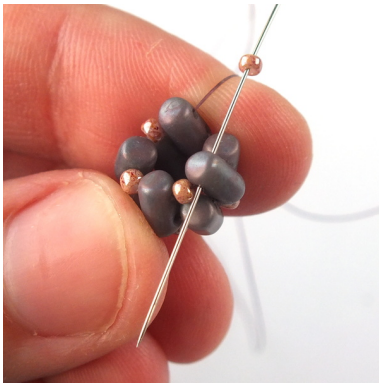
16) Repeat step 15 ...



12) Repeat step 11 ...



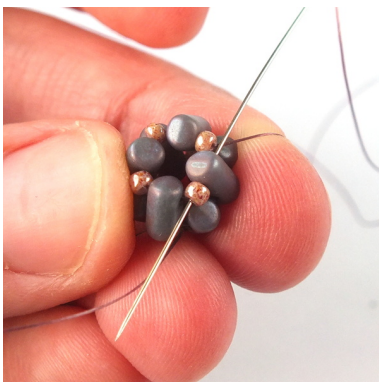
17) ... until you reach ...



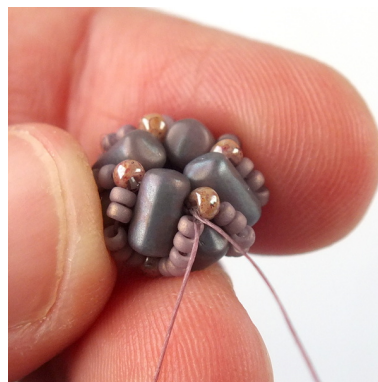
13) ... until you reach the end of the row.
Keep your tension as tight as possible.



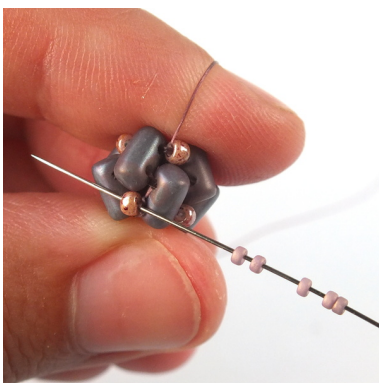
18) ... the end of the row.



14) Weave through the last row a few more times. The thread should exit from one of the 11/0s.



19) Weave through beads until you get to the starting point of the thread. Then tie a square knot, pass through few more beads and then cut both ends of the thread.



15) String five 15/0s and pass through the next 11/0 on the other side of the bead (as shown in the photo).



20) The bead is finished. Make a few more pieces and string them onto a beading wire to create a simple necklace or bracelet.

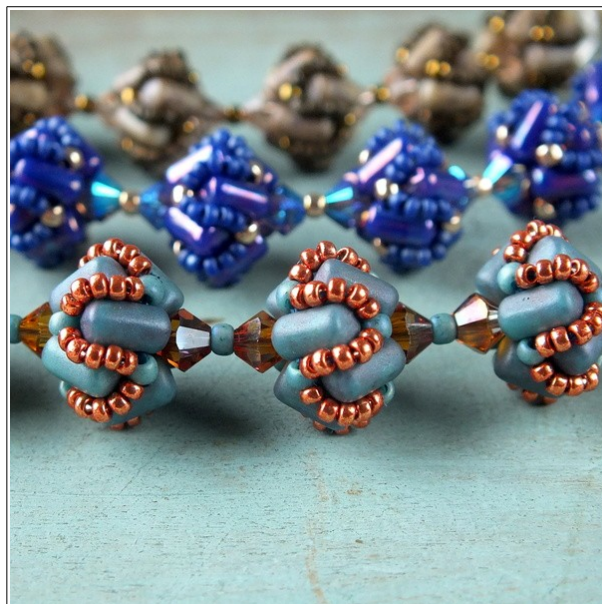
